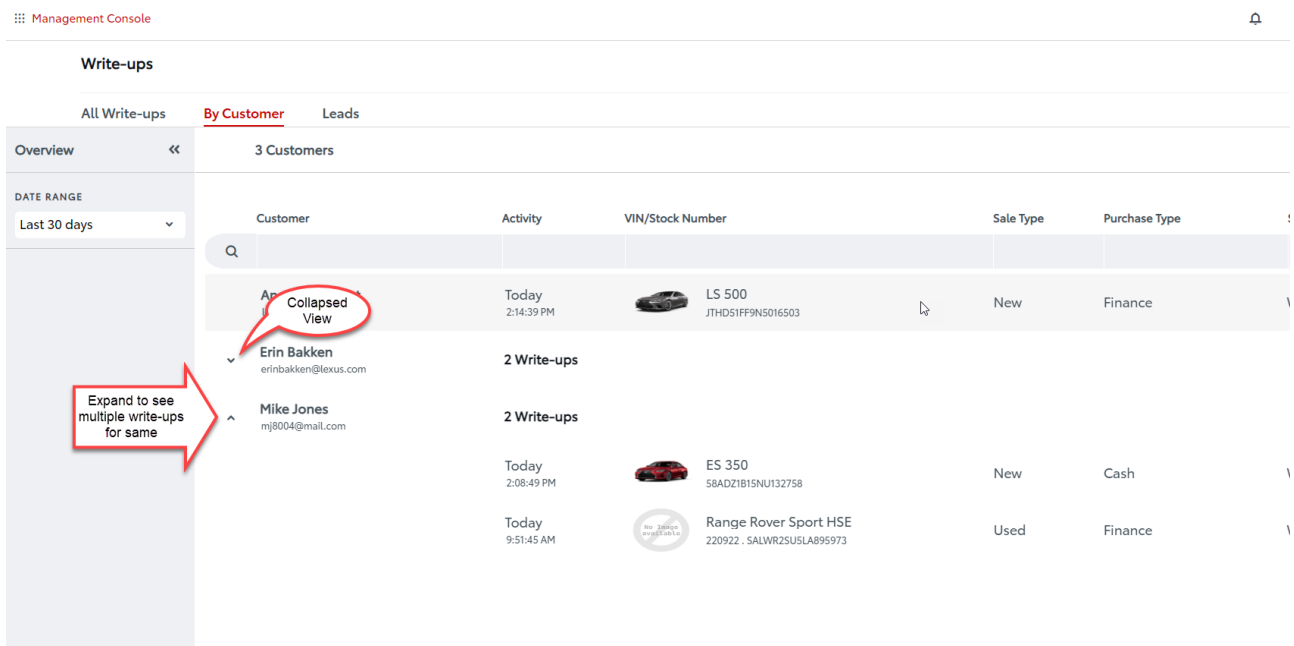


The Management Console Release on July 11th implements enhancements to the Homepage, Summary View, and Customer Menu.

Homepage Enhancements

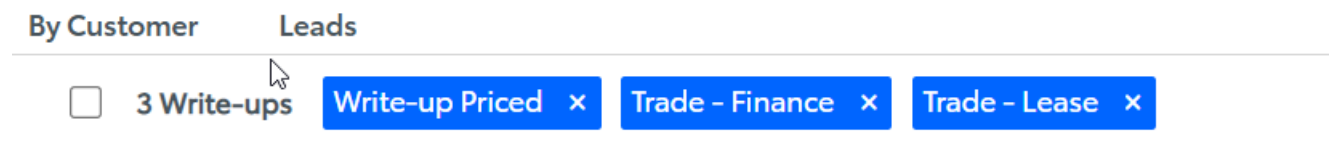
Collapsible View by Customer

Improved 'By Customer' view experience by grouping multiple write-ups for the same customer into a collapsible view. Users are Filter by Date Range or Search by Customer in the By Customer View. To filter or search on additional criteria please do so from the All Write-ups View.



All Write-Ups View Improvements

Filter Chips have been added to easily view the filter or search criteria being used to display write-ups. Filters can be cleared one at a time, or all at once. In addition an issue has been resolved that addresses retaining the filters that were set upon a refresh of the write-ups homepage. Retaining the filters when navigating back to the homepage after viewing/working on a write up was also resolved.



Summary Pane

Tool Tips with additional information regarding statuses have been added. To view, hover over each status.

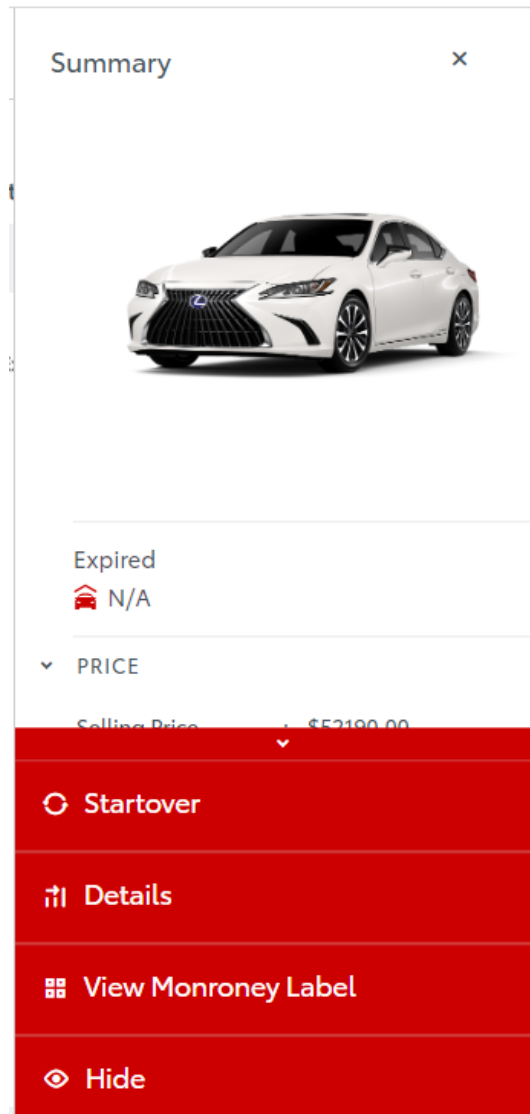
